

First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (Housing and Property Chamber)

### **Decision**

1. The Tribunal determined that the Respondent has complied with the Letting Agent Enforcement Order (LAEO) made on 2 November 2023.

## Background

2. On the 2 November 2023 the Tribunal decided that the Respondents had breached paragraphs 26, 93,108 and 113 of the Letting Agent Code of Practice and the Tribunal issued a LAEO in the following terms:

Within 30 days of their receipt of this Letting Agent Enforcement order the Respondents Ross Sales and Lettings shall:

- (1) Pay the Applicant the sum of three hundred and fifty pounds (£350) in respect of her inconvenience arising out of their failure to comply with the Letting Agent Code of Practice.
- (2) Provide to the Tribunal Chamber evidence of their compliance with this order.

3. The Respondents contacted the Tribunal on 18 December 2023 and stated that the payment was made on 4 December 2023. The Applicant contact the Tribunal on 21 December 2023 and advised that payment had been made.

### Reasons

- 4. Both the Applicant and Respondents have confirmed that the compensation has been paid.
- 5. The Tribunal is satisfied that the LAEO has been complied with in full. The Tribunal decision is unanimous.

# **Right of Appeal**

In terms of Section 46 of the Tribunal (Scotland) Act 2014, a party aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.
