The Tribunal makes the following Property Factor Enforcement Order

1. The property factor is required within a period of twenty eight days to make payment to the homeowner of the sum of £400.00.

In terms of section 46 of the Tribunals (Scotland) Act 2014, a party aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them

Failure to comply with a Property Factor Enforcement Order may have serious consequences and may constitute an offence.
