Decision with Statement of Reasons of the First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (Housing and Property Chamber) under Section 71 of the Private Housing (Tenancies) (Scotland) Act 2016

Decision

The First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (Housing and Property Chamber) ("the Tribunal") granted the Application to the extent of making a Payment Order in favour of the Applicant against the Respondent in the sum of £2,000.00.

Background

[1] The Applicant seeks a Payment Order for restoration costs said lawfully to be due to the Applicant following on from the ending of a tenancy between the parties.

The Case Management Discussion

[2] The Application called for a Case Management Discussion (CMD) by conference call at 2pm on 27 November 2003.

[3] The Applicant was represented by Mr Brian Webster. The Respondent was personally present. Neither party had any preliminary matter to raise. The parties discussed the matter and agreed a resolution during the CMD whereby the claim would be settled for £2,000.00. The Tribunal confirmed that both parties wished a Payment Order to be made in the sum of £2,000.00. That having been confirmed, the Tribunal made the order as now requested. The Respondent will consider applying for Time to Pay unless a payment plan can be agreed.

Right of Appeal

In terms of Section 46 of the Tribunal (Scotland) Act 2014, a party aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.
