



Decision with Statement of Reasons of the First-tier Tribunal for Scotland (Housing and Property Chamber) under Rule 26 of The First-tier Tribunal for Scotland Housing and Property Chamber (Procedure) Regulations 2017.

The Tribunal rejects the application by the Applicant under section 28 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 2006 requesting the Tribunal to consider offering assistance in exercising the Landlord's right of entry to the Property dated 1st May 2021.
