



**Certificate of the Homeowner Housing Panel issued under the Homeowner Housing Panel (Applications and Decisions) (Scotland) Regulations 2012**

**Decision of the Committee**

The Homeowner Housing Committee having determined that the Property Factor Enforcement Order ("the PFEO") relative to the property dated 24 January 2014 has been complied with, the Committee therefore certifies that the Factors have complied with the Order.

**Reasons for Decision**

Following a hearing into the Homeowner's complaint held on 18 December 2013, the HOHP Committee issued a decision on 23 December 2013 which was promulgated to the parties. A final PFEO was issued on 24 January 2014.

On 12 March 2014, the property Factor confirmed to the Homeowner Housing Committee that the actions required in the PFEO had been completed. On 17 March 2014, the Homeowner confirmed to the Homeowner Housing Committee that the actions required in the PFEO had been completed.

The Homeowner Housing Committee therefore decided to issue the present Certificate of Compliance. No further action is required of the Factors in terms of the said PFEO.

**Right of appeal**

The parties' attention is drawn to the terms of Section 22 of the Act regarding their right to appeal, and the time limit for doing so. It provides:-

- (1) An appeal on a point of law only may be made by summary application to the sheriff against a decision of the president of the homeowner housing panel or homeowner housing committee.
- (2) An appeal under subsection (1) must be made within the period of 21 days beginning with the day on which the decision appealed against is made.
