The Tribunal proposes to make the following Property Factor Enforcement Order

- The Property Factor is ordered to make payment of SIX HUNDRED POUNDS (£600.00) to the Homeowner within 28 days of the date of this Decision.

Review of Tribunal's Decision

In terms of section 46 of the Tribunals (Scotland) Act 2014, a party aggrieved by the decision of the Tribunal may appeal to the Upper Tribunal for Scotland on a point of law only. Before an appeal can be made to the Upper Tribunal, the party must first seek permission to appeal from the First-tier Tribunal. That party must seek permission to appeal within 30 days of the date the decision was sent to them.

Failure to comply with a Property Factor Enforcement Order may have serious consequences and may constitute an offence.
