Statement of Facts and Reasons

Section 60 Housing (Scotland) Act 2006

Certificate of Completion
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1. The surveyor member of the Private Rented Housing Committee ( Mr Mowatt ) re-inpected the property on $4^{\text {th }}$ July 2012 in the presence of the new owner Mr Mark Rennie in order to ascertain whether the works required by the Repairing Standard Enforcement Order dated 28/2/11 had been completed.
2. The following was noted:-

A schedule of works from a specialist contractor was made available.

A damp proof course has been installed and when tested with a damp meter the affected walls appear to be dry.

The gas central heating system has been replaced. There are new radiators throughout the property and a combi boiler has been wall mounted in the kitchen. A gas safety certificate was produced and inspected.

The electrics have been upgraded including new power points and lighting.

Further internal improvements have been undertaken including new kitchen and bathroom fittings, joinery replacement and redecoration.
3. In light of the foregoing the Committee is satisfied that all the works required by the aforementioned RSEO have been carried out. Accordingly the Committee grants a Certificate of Completion.
