The Private Rented Housing Committee having determined on 28th October 2014 that the work required by the **Repairing Standard Enforcement Order** relative to the Property served on 25th October 2012 has been completed, revokes the Rent Relief Order served on on 9 April 2013 with effect from the date of service of this Notice.

A landlord or a tenant aggrieved by this decision of the Private Rented Housing Committee may appeal to the Sheriff by summary application within 21 days of being notified of that decision.

Where such an appeal is made, the effect of the revocation is suspended until the appeal is abandoned or finally determined, and where the appeal is abandoned or finally determined by confirming the decision, the revocation will be treated as having effect from the day on which the appeal is abandoned or so determined.
